BACKFLOW BASICS AND CROSS CONNECTION CONTROL FOR IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

BASIC WATER AUDITING/IRRIGATION TROUBLESHOOTING

This workshop will cover pre-audit, water auditing and understanding the results of the water audit. By using the audit, you will learn to how to make the changes that will save water and money. Water management will be covered as well. Basic troubleshooting will help you understand the irrigation system and its components. Using basic knowledge of the system will prepare you to diagnose and repair the problems.
